- 3. Complete a <u>Minor Authorization / Change form</u> as instructed by the minor advisor. This may be done in a meeting or via email
- 4. Email a copy of the Minor Authorization / Change form signed by you and the minor advisor to <a href="mailto:artdesign.advising@rit.edu">artdesign.advising@rit.edu</a> for approval and processing

#### How to View your Academic Advisement Report (AAR):

- 1. Log into SIS
- 2. Select the "Academic Records" icon
- 3. Select "My Academic Requirements" from menu on left side of screen
- 4. Once in the report, you will know a requirement or category is completed when it is closed. Requirements that still need to be completed will be open. If you would like, you can select the "expand all" button on the top of your AAR to easily see each section of requirements.
